As someone with a math background, I sometimes get excited about numbers. The current Scripture Access Statistics from Wycliffe contain some truly exciting numbers. While the number of languages that still need Bible translation work to start seems overwhelming (almost 1,000), the number currently in process is over 1,500 and more than 200 new translation projects have been started in the last year. At these rates, we're within 4 or 5 years of having translation work started in every language that needs it. Praise God for an exciting time in history.

In the meantime, winter at Moody looks similar to previous winters. As bad weather predictably rolls in, Moody schedules fewer flights and more classroom and simulator training. For maintenance, this gives us an opportunity to catch up on maintenance issues that are important but not urgent (but could become urgent if not taken care of), such as repairing cowl flap hinges and replacing seals in a carb heat box. Pray that we'll complete the necessary projects in order to prepare the airplanes for the next busy flying season.
