Improving Weather

As weather improves, our students do less classroom and simulator time and more flight time. Third-year students are just learning to take off and land and are doing their first solo flights. Fourth and fifth year students are taking advantage of the variety of terrain available locally, with landings on grass runways in the mountains or a sand runway on the coast. For our maintenance team, this means we've completed most of our winter projects and are into the routine of regular inspections. Pray that we'll keep up with the work to be done. Also, pray that we'll be able to bring on board one more mechanic.

First and second year students have several math and physics classes that provide foundational knowledge for both maintenance and flight, so I've been doing some tutoring for Moody students in the evenings. Last semester, I worked with a Moody student from Indonesia who understood the math concepts but struggled with the language barrier. This semester, I'm working with a Moody student from South Africa who understands English quite well, but missed some prerequisite concepts in previous schooling. Pray that these students would learn what they each need in order to succeed both at Moody and where God leads them next.

As I've said many times before, Deborah continues to have seizures. The implant has helped, but she had a bad enough seizure in March that she spent a night in the Emergency Room. We've been to Seattle several times for settings adjustment and additional testing. Pray for wisdom for the doctors. Also pray for safe travel for repeated upcoming appointments in Seattle.
